

AS2S is the second version of our Asbestos Framework and is part of the SPA Compliance set of frameworks - Fire, Legionella, Asbestos and Gas.

The framework is split into separate regional lots all assessed individually and include suppliers who have demonstrated the competence and experience to undertake services or works within that region.

14 suppliers submitted tenders and through our electronic portal and the evaluation process appointed 11 companies onto the framework as these offered best Value for Money.
