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WHY HAS THIS FRAMEWORK BEEN DEVELOPED?

The Asset Safety and Compliance (ASC1) Framework was designed to offer a suite of asset safety and compliance support to help the public sector meet government guidelines and legal responsibilities relating to building life safety and maintenance.

What was clear throughout our engagement process was a requirement for a comprehensive suite of asset safety and compliance disciplines in a single framework designed to offer an efficient, value for money procurement route for local authorities, social landlords and other public sector bodies to source specialist suppliers who can provide a full suite of asset safety and compliance support services.

Key features:

- ✓ Suite of asset safety and compliance disciplines providing a method to meet government guidelines regarding life safety, property protection and maintenance
- ✓ Access to a pool of consultancy and compliance-related expertise through a single framework
- ✓ Access to consultancy and surveying specialists for the management and removal of asbestos
- ✓ Access to expertise in property protection, water management, gas safety and heating servicing, asbestos and electrical testing.

About this framework

Throughout our extensive pre-tender engagement (PTE) process our Partners in the public sector acknowledged the positive contribution our existing frameworks in property protection (V7), asbestos services (AS2) and water management (WM1) have made in delivering effective life safety systems in the management and maintenance of their assets and resulting benefits to their tenants and building users.

Our response has been to combine these services and enhance the framework offering further with two additional workstreams covering gas safety, heating, electrical inspection, testing and servicing in both commercial and residential settings. The result is a framework designed to offer a comprehensive and wide-ranging suite of services to the public sector to assist in meeting building life safety and maintenance, government guidelines and legal responsibilities with the flexibility to meet their needs and community priorities more effectively.

The tender was carried out in strict accordance with the Public Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 2015. Places on the framework were awarded to 31 different suppliers in five workstreams. The companies appointed to the framework are experts in their field, with a proven track record in delivering projects with public sector Partners.

The term of the framework is from **4th September 2023 to 3rd September 2027**, while workstream 4a Gas Safety - Domestic runs from **18th September 2023 to 17th September 2027**. Individual call-off projects can be completed beyond the four-year duration of the framework as long as a contract is in place prior to the framework expiry date.


Our Vision for Asset Safety and Compliance



WEIGHTING, ACCREDITATION AND CERTIFICATIONS

A single stage open tender process was used as set out within the Public Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 2015.

Consultancy Lots – Priced hourly, and day rates
For Inspections and Maintenance – Lot specific pricing structure includes elements of the schedule of day rates, overheads and profits.
The Bidder with the lowest total price for each regional area within a lot will achieve the highest price score for that regional area within the lot, and higher priced Bidders' scores will be indexed against the lowest priced Bidder.

Lot Specific Accreditations / Certification

Where applicable evidence of the relevant accreditations, certifications, and membership of trade bodies applicable to the lot they are awarded to was required.

Quality Management*

The relevant accredited certificated scheme in compliance with BS EN ISO 9001 or equivalent.

Compliance with Equality Act 2010

Confirmatory statements they are compliant with the Equality Act 2010 and have measures in place to promote equality and diversity within their organisation.

*Where certification was not held, Appointed Companies were required to complete the appropriate PAS 91 questions to evidence

EVALUATION

CRITERIA CONTINUED

Financial Stability Assessment

Appointed Companies were assessed on their financial stability based on a range of financial information including post-tax profit and current liabilities and checked via Creditsafe. The results of this check were assessed on a pass/fail basis.

Minimum Insurance Cover

Throughout the duration of the framework Appointed Companies are required to have the minimum levels of insurance as follows:

All suppliers are required to have £5m Employers Liability Insurance and £5m Public Liability Insurance. Asbestos consultants, water management consultants and electrical testing companies are also expected to have £2m Professional Indemnity Insurance.

Companies on the workstreams for heating servicing and electrical testing will also have £2m Product Liability Insurance.



CALL-OFF AWARD OPTIONS

THE FRAMEWORK ALLOWS PARTNERS THE OPTION OF:

Direct award without further competition, where all terms and conditions of the call-off project are within the terms and conditions of the framework

OR

Mini-competition, where terms and conditions of the call-off may vary or be modified from the framework or at the choice of the Partner.

When calling off projects, Partners can use any one of a range of standard forms of building contract including JCT/SBCC, NEC/NEC4, ACE, PPC, TPC, FAC1, or their own in-house agreement.

THIS FRAMEWORK IS INCLUDED WITHIN OUR CALL OFF SERVICE.

The SPA Call Off Service is available free of charge to Partners. Our team conduct the call off mini competition while delivering best practice guidance and continuous support throughout the process.

ELIGIBILITY

SPA is a not-for-profit organisation, governed by public law and a central purchasing body providing procurement services. 
